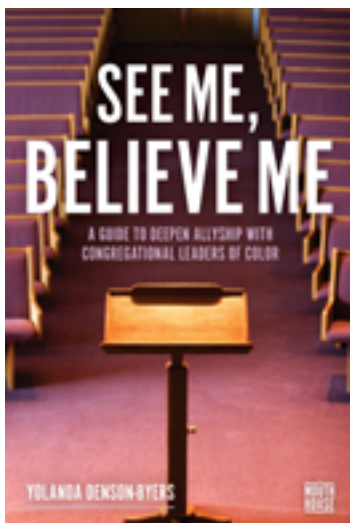


Ashes to Action: Finding Myself at the Intersection of the Minneapolis Uprising ● New release

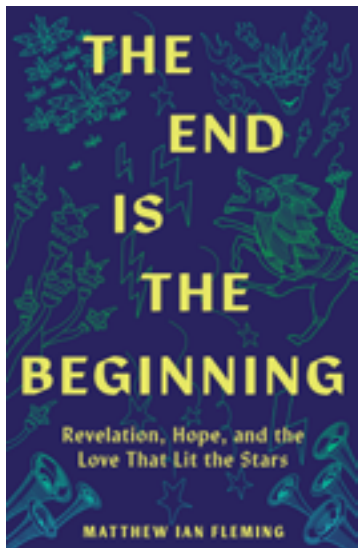

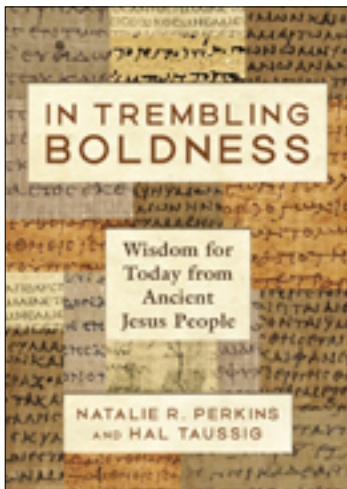

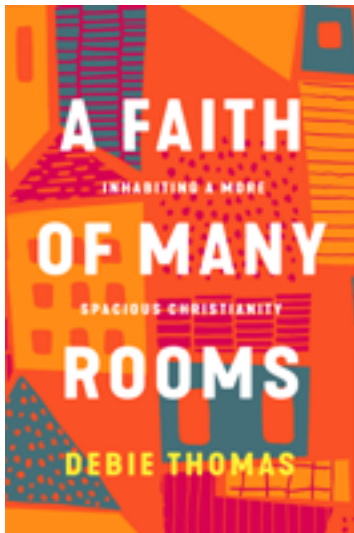


In My Grandmother's House: Black Women, Faith, and the Stories We Inherit

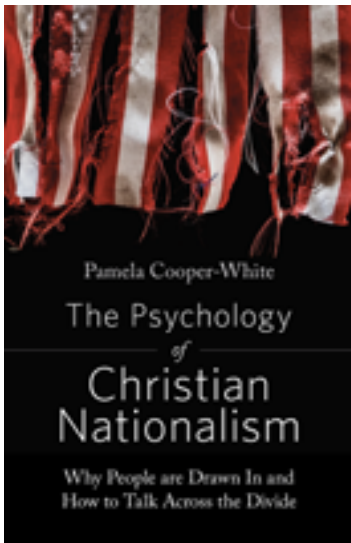


Red State Christians: A Journey into White Christian Nationalism and the Wreckage It Leaves Behind

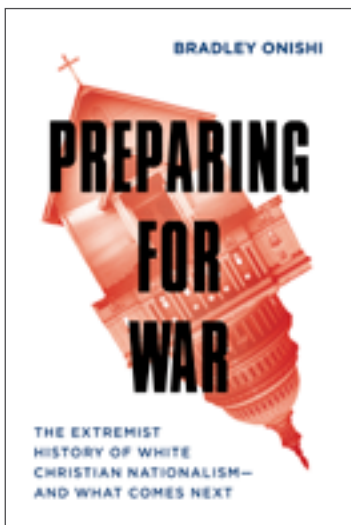

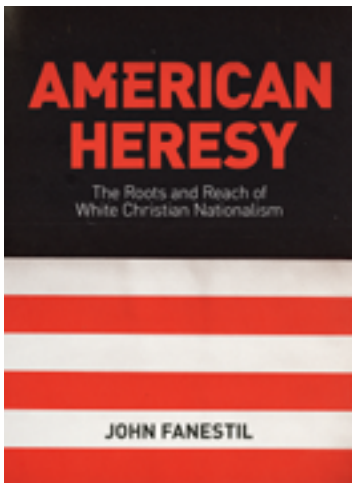

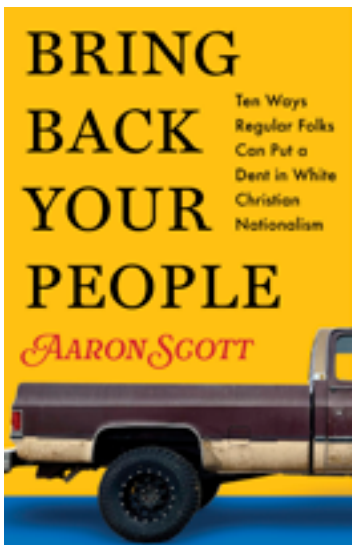

The very same principles that underpin the United States' proudest moments also forged the white Christian nationalism that fruited so dangerously in the Capitol insurrection of January 6, 2021. Far from a fringe movement embraced by a violent few, white Christian nationalism is a spiritual inheritance shared by all white American Christians. Grappling with this history is vital if the United States is ever to move beyond its tragic legacy.
