





Rather than ask your congregants to leave their political and theological beliefs at the church door, launch into a healthy conversation about the role of the church in our politically-divisive culture today. Battles over moral issues like abortion rights and homosexuality have now widened to include taxation and size of government, so that specific church affiliation has become an accurate predictor of political party affiliation. Allen Hilton believes that religion isn't inherently divisive, and in *A House United*, he suggests a new role for Christianity. Jesus prayed that his disciples might all be one, and this book imagines a proper answer to that prayer in the context of American polarization.
