Topical studies on baptism, communion, the lectionary, worship and ecology, and more can be used for adult forums as well as for individuals who seek greater understanding. Each study includes questions to guide conversation.

Those who gather for worship have important questions about worship, especially if they are new to Lutheran worship. When time is of the essence, it is essential to have resources you can count on. All the titles in this series explore how and why our worship matters in an accessible and helpful manner.
