Welcome to the Early Childhood Digital Activity Kit for Advent and Christmas! This kit includes activities for children to do with their families to anticipate and celebrate the joy of the birth of Jesus.

Kit Preparation Supplies

Assembling the Kits

Follow the steps below to prep each activity included in the Digital Activity Kit. Then put it all together in a kit for each family in your church with children ages 1–5 years old.

Coloring Pages

- 1. On 8.5 x 11-inch paper, print one set of coloring pages for each child.
- 2. If desired, include washable markers or crayons for kids to use.

Activity Placemats

- 1. On 11 x 17-inch paper, print one set of Activity Placemats for each family.
- 2. Laminate each placemat using clear self-adhesive paper or a laminator.
- 3. If desired, include dry-erase markers for kids to use.

Frolic Story Puppets

- 1. On cardstock, print a set of puppets for each family, along with the list of stories.
- 2. If desired, cut out the puppets and tape them to craft sticks or include tape and craft sticks so families can cut out and assemble the puppets at home.
- 3. Provide a Frolic First Bible or Frolic Preschool Bible for each family, depending on the age of their kids.

Little Mole's Christmas Gift Mini Lesson

- 1. Print a copy of the Mini Lesson for each family.
- 2. Provide each family with a copy of Little Mole's Christmas Gift (Beaming Books, 2020).

Felt Advent Wreath

- 1. Collect enough supplies to make a felt-board Advent wreath for each family with infants, toddlers, and preschoolers.
- 2. Glue the dark backing to the foam board, and cut out one set of felt shapes per family.
- 3. Provide the set for the family to assemble and interact with at home.

Advent Service Calendar

- 1. Print out a set of instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide supplies for families to create a calendar of their own at home.

Animal Ears and Noses

- 1. On cardstock, print out a set of animal ears for each family.
- 2. Provide scissors, tape, and dollar-store headbands for them to cut out and assemble the ears to wear, and add a single-hole punch and stretchy cord to make the noses wearable.

Jesus Shines in Our Hearts Ornament

- 1. Print out a copy of the ornament instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide supplies to make the ornaments.

Peppermint Hot Cocoa Recipe

- 1. Print out a copy of the recipe for each family.
- 2. Provide ingredients to make the cocoa.

- 2. On 8.5 x 11-inch paper, print one set of coloring pages for each kid.
- 3. If desired, include washable markers or crayons for kids to use.

Advent and Christmas Family Trivia Cards

- 1. On a perforated business card template, print one set of Trivia Cards for each family.
- 2. Tear the cards apart and put each stack into an envelope or wrap a rubber band around them.

Spark, Holy Moly, and Whirl Bible Reading Guides

- 1. Choose the Reading Guides that fit the curriculum brand(s) you use.
- 2. Print a copy of the Reading Guide for each family.
- 3. If desired, provide Spark, Whirl, Holy Moly, or Connect Bibles for families to use at home, if they don't already have one.

The World of the First Christians Fact-Finding Challenge

- 1. Print a copy of the activity for each child in each family.
- 2. Provide a copy of *The World of the First Christians: A Curious Kid's Guide to the Early Church* (Beaming Books, 2020) for each family.
- 3. If desired, provide writing utensils.

Spark, Holy Moly, and Whirl Christmas Worship Invitations

- 1. Choose the Christmas Worship Invitations that fit the curriculum brand(s) you use.
- 2. Print the invitations on an Avery postcard template or on cardstock.
- 3. Fill in the appropriate information on the invitations.
- 4. Cut or separate the invitations and give to families to invite someone new to church.

Advent Service Calendar

- 1. Print out a set of instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide supplies for families to create a calendar of their own at home.

Advent Wreath

- 1. Print the activity instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide supplies for families to make their own Advent wreath at home.

Arroz Doce Recipe

- 1. Print the recipe for each family.
- 2. Provide the ingredients and supplies for families to make the recipe at home.

The Gift of Jesus Ornament

- 1. Print the activity instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide the supplies for families to make the ornament at home.

Assembling the Kits

Bible Reading Guide

- 1. Print a copy of the Reading Guide for each student.
- 2. Make sure each student has a Colaborate Student Bible, Connect Bible, or other Bible.

Advent Care Calendar

- 1. Print out a set of instructions for each student.
- 2. Provide supplies for families to create a calendar to give away to another family.

Trivia Cards

- 1. On a perforated business card template, print one set of Trivia Cards for each student.
- 2. Tear the cards apart and put each stack into an envelope or wrap a rubber band around them.

Journal Pages

- 1. Print one set of the Journal Pages for each student.
- 2. Cut out each page and glue them in order into a composition notebook. Make one notebook for each student.
- 3. If desired, include writing utensils for each student.

Advent Wreath

- 1. Print out the activity instructions for each student.
- 2. Provide the supplies to make the wreath at home.

Three Kings Cake Recipe

- 1. Print the instructions for each family.
- 2. Provide the ingredients to make the cake at home. Make sure students know what additional equipment they'll need.

Worship Notes

- 1. Print a copy of the Advent and Christmas Worship Notes pages for each student.
- 2. Set up a time for students to discuss their completed Worship Notes with you and/or their youth group.
