





1 I will bless the Lord at all times; the praise of God shall ever be in my mouth.  
 3 Proclaim with me the greatness of the LORD; let us exalt God's name together.  
 5 Look upon the Lord and be radiant, and let not your faces be shamed.  
 7 The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear the LORD, and delivers them.  
 9 Fear the Lord, you saints of the LORD, for those who fear the LORD lack nothing.  
 11 Come, children, and listen to me; I will teach you reverence for the LORD.  
 13 Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from lying words.  
 15 The eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, and God's ears are open to their cry.  
 17 The righteous cry, and the Lord hears them and delivers them from all their troubles.  
 19 Many are the troubles of the righteous, but the LORD delivers them from every one.

 20 God will keep safe all their bones; not one of them shall be broken.  
 22 O LORD, you redeem the life of your servants, and those who put their trust in you will not be punished.
